PUBLIC NOTICE

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER
Multiple Violations at WINFIELD PWS – 2023 to 2024**

**Este informe contiene información muy importante sobre su agua potable.

The Winfield PWS public water system (ID # MO6010866, Lincoln Co.) has had multiple violations of monitoring requirements and drinking water standards from **January 2023** through **May 2024**. During this time period this system incurred two (2) monitoring violations. Public notice is required for both of these violations, but has not been reported for either of them.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. This system failed to submit a routine sample for bacteriological testing in **January 2023** and **May 2024**, resulting in a major monitoring violation for each month.

During the months of monitoring violations, we cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water. Bacteriologically-contaminated water can cause a variety of disease symptoms. It is important to routinely test drinking water to ensure the safety of those that consume it.

Public notice is required for both these violations, but has not been reported for either of them. Performing public notice now resolves this issue. Please share this information with all the other people who drink this water, especially those who may not have direct access to this information. You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.
